What is a School-Based Health Center?

- A partnership between a medical provider and the school
- Located in or linked to a school
- Provide comprehensive services, including physical & behavioral health services
- Focus on prevention
- Prioritize serving students
- Currently, there are 64 SBHCs in Illinois

2016-2017 National School-Based Health Care Census


- Conducted by national School-Based Health Alliance every two years
- In last Census, 56/65 SBHCs reported for IL
- Unless otherwise indicated, data in this presentation is reflective of those that responded to the Census

Accessibility



- Average number of hours that a SBHC is open per week: 38
- Percentage of SBHCs that are open during the summer: 75%
- Percentage of SBHCs that see populations other than students: 82%
- Nearly all SBHCs bill for their services, including private insurers and Medicaid MCOs

Population Served


- All SBHCs see students from the school, and some SBHCs will see additional populations
- 84% of SBHC users are enrolled in Medicaid or are uninsured
- 62% of users are aged 12-20




Location






