The Ligas Family Advocate Program is funded by the Department of Human Services

The Ligas Family Advocate Program

- Established as a pilot program in 2014 after the Ligas Consent Decree (2011) to provide consistent information about waiver services and living options statewide
- Connect families of loved ones with I/DD to similar families seeking funding and services selected from the PUNS
- Share creative ways to utilize waiver funding
- Funded through a grant from the Illinois Department of Human Services
- Work with Independent Service Coordination agencies (ISCs) in getting information about all available options for services to adults and families https://www.thearcofil.org/about-us/programs/ligas-family-advocate-program/

PUNS Selection Letter

Summer following Early Notification

<u>Invitation to apply for Home and Community Based Waiver Services</u>

Evaluation process required – planned in partnership with ISC (contact upon receiving the letter of invitation)

Psychological Evaluation

Medical Exam

Ensure Medicaid in place

Continue to explore Developmental Disability Providers in your area

Contact Ligas Family Advocate Program

Once evaluation process complete, and individual is approved for services, you will receive an Award letter confirming that you will receive waiver funding

Home Based v CILA

Both provide services and supports to individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities

Both can be provided in various home environments

CORE DIFFERENCE: Who MANAGES the services?

- 1. Home-based Supports and Services: Family and Individual manage the services
- 2. CILA: Developmental Disability Provider Agency manages the services

Key Roles within Home-Based

- Self-Advocate & Family
- PSW
- Fiscal Agent
- Employer of Record
- Self-Direction Assistant

How can you use DDD waiver funding once eligible?

Home-based Services Program: (funding is fixed =3 times SSI); all services/supports must fit within monthly budget (\$2,382.00).

Example of common services:

- Personal Support Worker (PSW)
- Community Day Services(CDS) program
- SDA -Self-Direction Assistant; optional service (\$50.26)/hour for assistance in arranging for, directing & managing PSW services, skills re: recruiting/hiring of PSWs, info on effective communication and problem solving skills

OR

CILA –no fixed funding amount

- Group Home (24/7 care –up to 8 individuals)
- Host Home (24/7)
- Intermittent/In home-family CILA (less than 24/7 care daily)
 - House you live in with your family (family CILA)
 - Your own apartment can be a permanent supportive housing apt.

Services of the DDD waiver: HBS "Menu"

HOME BASED SERVICES (HBS) PROGRAM –Fixed funding (3x SSI Monthly)

Individualized Service and Support Advocacy -ISC

Supported employment (SEP) –auth. & prior approval

Community Day Service (CDS) program; temporary intensive staffing in CDS program –auth. & prior approval

Behavior Counseling (individual & Group)

Behavior Intervention and Treatment; Psychotherapy

Adult day care if 60 or older or medically fragile

Support Services Team

PT/OT/Speech Therapy—auth. & prior approval

Adaptive Equipment – auth. & prior approval

Assistive Technology—auth. & prior approval

Home Accessibility & Vehicle Modifications – auth/prior approval

Self-Direction Assistance (SDA)

Personal Support – Personal Support Worker (PSW)

Temporary Assistance (if PSW unavailable)—prior auth. & approval

Nursing; Emergency Home Response Services; non-medical transportation; training and counseling for unpaid caregivers; out of home respite, adult day care (60 and older)—auth. & prior approval; Other Day Program — auth. & prior approval

Note – Many supports require preapproval; always talk with you ISC before scheduling services

What HBS Supports are used most often?

Personal Support Workers (PSW)

Community Day Services (CDS)

Self-Direction Assistance (SDA)

Where can I use Home Based Services?

- In the house where I live with my family
- In a house where I live on my own or with a roommate
- In a condo where I live on my own or with a roommate
- In supportive housing

Read core information, apply for Medicaid and SSI at age 18
