The Role of the Independent Service Coordination Agency: ISC



GIVING A CHOICE AND PROVIDING A VOICE

ISC: GATEWAY TO DD SERVICES IN ILLINOIS

We are the link between the Division of Developmental Services: DDD and the service providers with the goal of providing conflict free case management and assisting individuals and families to navigate the service system.

Core ISC Role



The ISC contracts with the IDHS/DDD to perform certain functions as outlined in the DDD Medicaid Waiver and CMS Regulations.



ISC's are each responsible for a certain geographic area.



Community Service Options is responsible for the south and west sides of Chicago.

Preadmission Screening: PAS



Our agencies are often referred to as PAS agencies, Pre-Admission Screening agencies



PAS responsibilities include:

- > Determining clinical eligibility for DD Waiver services
- > Enrolling individuals on the PUNS database
- Linking eligible individuals who are either in a crisis (as defined by DDD) or who are selected from PUNS or who are transitioning out of an SODC with services and providers.

In Service Support



Once in service we are responsible for:

- > Completing the annual Discovery and Personal Plan
- ➤ Visiting with individuals to assess their satisfaction with services
- ➤ Providing case management, advocacy, outreach and assistance to individuals and families

What does that mean for someone in Home-Based Supports and Services?

- ➤ By completing the Discovery Tool and Personal Plan, the ISC outlines the direction of the services for all involved.
- The ISC assists with locating waiver service providers.
- > The ISC assists in resolving conflicts with service providers.
- The ISC processes applications for supports such as Home Modification, Support Services Team, Vehicle Moodification, Adaptive Equipment, etc..
- > The ISC may assist with Medicaid redetermination issues.
- ➤ The ISC may help with linkage to non-waiver supports.
- > The ISC is your go to support in navigating the service delivery system.
