You are certainly free to pay an employee any amount you desire(\$17.77 or \$12.13, etc.) as long as your wages are within the State's funding parameters and at least minimum wage for your specific area. (Currently \$14.00/hour for City of Chicago; \$13.60/hour for Cook County; \$12.00/hour for the rest of Illinois.) You can calculate a rough "Cost to You" by multiplying the wage you wish to pay by 108.0%
