EVV UPDATE ON LIVE-IN CAREGIVERS

DDD wanted to remind stakeholders that, last week, HFS announced an update to the EVV requirements for live-in caregivers. Personal Support Workers (PSWs) who meet the definition of live-in caregiver <u>will</u> be exempt from complying with EVV requirements.
