



Illinois Crisis Nurseries for Children from Birth to Age 6:

Formed by the Crisis Nursery Congressional Act of 1986, Illinois' seven crisis nurseries provide holistic prevention and intervention services 24/7 to families with young children up to age 6 who are in crisis (lost employment, medical emergencies, violence, or family dysfunction) and at high risk of abuse and neglect. The goals are to reduce parental stress, improve parenting skills and reduce the risk of child maltreatment.
