# In-Home Respite

### What are the Eligibility Requirements?

Individuals with a diagnosis of Autism,
Cerebral Palsy, Epilepsy or an intellectual/
developmental disability are eligible for this
program at no cost to the family. Our inhome program is funded through a DHS
respite grant.

#### Who Do We Serve?

We serve statewide except for Cook county and first refer to respite agencies in your area.

#### Who can be an IRC Respite Worker?

We can train a person of your choice as long as they are over 18 years old, and do not live in the family home. We pay over \$14.50 an hour for one child, rates increase based on the number of eligible children.
