What is a Mental Health Board?

- -Government body passes referendum
- -Mental Health Board created
- -Up to .15% of property tax collected
- -Funds reallocated to contract for services in mental health, substance use, and developmental disability.
- -Up to appointed Mental Health Board members how funds are reallocatedinformed by Needs Assessment and Strategic Plan





How TIDE came to be...



Needs Assessment Process

- -Focus Groups
- -Caregivers and people with DD- said transportation





Service Providers

-Also reporting transportation as an issue.

-Individual Service Coordinator reported the burden of transportation on

caregivers...especially with young adults







What already exists and what is the need?

-Hanover Township is metropolitan Chicago...lots of resources

- -PACE bus? Uber? Taxi? Volunteers?
- -How to narrow down the need?
- -MHB chose one focus...employment/training.





Local Business to the Rescue!










- -Contracted with A1 Cabs
- -Voucher based program
- -Riders purchase vouchers from me for half the cost of ride.
- -Riders arrange ride with A1.
- -Cab picks up rider, rider provides voucher. No money exchanged.
- -A1 invoices the MHB for total cost of rides on monthly basis.





Walk through a new rider...

- -Rider contacts me for application.
- -Cost of ride determined and communicated to rider.
- -Rider fills out application.
- -I notify A1 Taxi of new rider and scan application to them.





Walk through a new rider....

- -Rider is notified of acceptance and receives instructions for use.
- -Rider purchases vouchers from me.
- -Rider arranges ride with A1 Cab.
- -A1 Cab includes rider on monthly invoice.

- -Costs per mile
- -Riders can purchase as much as they like at once.
- -Cash, credit or checkeven over the phone
- -Caregivers purchase as well.





TIDE Stats

- -We budget around \$20,000 for program.
- -We average 228 rides per month.
- -We have about 30 enrolled riders, but average 15 regular riders each month.
- -Last fiscal year, we provided 2,156 rides.
- -3 CILA residents
- -6 Permanent Supportive Housing Residents
- -2 College Students
- -Currently 23 Employers
- -3 Day Programs

Lessons Learned


- Flexibility is a must-ability to mail vouchers, take cards, etc.
- More than one person needs to be available to sell vouchers.
- Taxi drivers may need some training.
- Some riders need extra attention.

Some caregivers need extra

attention.

 Check with taxi company before growth.

 Communicate regularly with riders and caregivers.
