What Medicaid Covers for People with Disabilities

- Early intervention therapies for infants and toddlers
- Nursing, personal assistance, day programs, and group homes that allow people to live in the community
- Items not covered by insurance, such as equipment and supplies to live, move, and communicate
- School-based health, mental health, and therapy services
- Healthcare for children and adults with disabilities
