



What is a Bill?

- All laws begin as ideas. These ideas may come from a legislator (also known as a lawmaker) or from a citizen like you.
- Ideas can become a bill, and all laws begin as bills.
- Before a bill can become a law, it must be approved by the House of Representatives, the Senate, and the Governor.

What is a Hearing? - 1

- When a bill is introduced, it gets assigned a number and gets sent to a committee:
 - Human Services
 - Education
 - Consumer Protection
 - Workforce Development

What is a Hearing? - 2

- Committee members review, research and revise the bill.
- If committee members want more information, a hearing is held, and people can attend to speak up and speak out!

Ways to Speak Up and Speak Out

- Testify in person



- Witness Slip

What is a Witness Slip?

- A public record of a person or group's position on a particular bill
- A slip that is filled out electronically instead of on paper with a pen or pencil
- Can be filed by individuals on behalf of themselves, or on behalf of organizations
- Can be filed for any bill scheduled for a hearing in the Illinois Senate or House Committee

Why Submit a Witness Slip?

- Witness slips are important because they let lawmakers know where people and organizations stand before they vote on a piece of legislation



How Can I File a Witness Slip?

- You can file a witness slip electronically using a computer, tablet, or smart phone



When Should I file My Witness Slip?

- Your witness slip can be submitted as soon as a committee hearing is posted
- You should file your witness slip a day before the committee but at least one hour before the committee hearing to ensure that it is accounted for and read by the committee
- Witness slips can be submitted up to the end of the day of the committee's scheduled date

Does One Witness Slip Follow Each Hearing For My Bill? (1 of 3)

- **No.** You will need to submit a witness slip for each committee hearing posted. For example, your bill may be posted twice within the same week. You will need to submit a witness slip both times, **HOWEVER...**

Does One Witness Slip Follow Each Hearing For My Bill? (2 of 3)


- If your bill is heard in a committee hearing that has been rescheduled for a different time that same day, your witness slip will remain connected with that piece of legislation.

Does One Witness Slip Follow Each Hearing For My Bill? (3 of 3)

- If the piece of legislation is heard in a committee hearing that has been rescheduled to a different day, you will have to submit a new witness slip for the new posting date

Once I Have Filed a Witness Slip, Can I Change My Mind and Delete It?

- **No.** Even if you change your mind, once you file a Witness Slip, it stays on the record. It can be searched for and found years later.

Why Register and Create an Account? (1 of 2)

- Saves your user information such as name, address, phone number, email, business and representation, eliminating the need to re-enter the information on each Witness Slip
- Easy to create a Witness Slip in just a few clicks
- View your Witness Slips filed for each chamber for the current General Assembly
- Filter and sort by committee name, date/time and legislation number

Why Register and Create an Account? (2 of 2)

- Update user information, testimony and positions on filed Witness Slips
- Log on to the ILGA (Illinois Legislative General Assembly) Dashboard to enter and manage Witness Slips





Filing a Witness Slip Without Registering For An Account

Filing Without an Account (1 of 2)

- You can enter electronic Witness slips on a piece of legislation or on subject matter in committee without registering or logging on.
- Usually used by first time users or users that enter in Witness Slips very infrequently.
- It **does not** allow you to edit a slip once it is submitted.

Filing Without an Account (2 of 2)

- Sometimes you will have a link to file an electronic witness slip. Clicking the link will take you directly to the Witness Slip for that particular bill. Other times you may need to search for the bill that you want to file a witness slip for.

Completing the Witness Slip

1. Under I. IDENTIFICATION, fill in the following:
 - a. Name
 - b. Address
 - c. City
 - d. State
 - e. Zip code
 - f. Firm/Business Agency
 - i. This is the organization to which you are connected. Examples may include the name of your self-advocacy group, the name of the agency/organization that supports you, The Illinois Self-Advocacy Alliance, Inc., etc.
 - g. Title
 - i. This is how you identify yourself. Examples may include self-advocate, ambassador, director, etc.
 - h. Email
 - i. Phone number



Filing a Witness Slip by Searching for the Bill
